

## Information for Hirers of Kenton Victory Hall

### Fire

You must make yourself aware of the location of the fire alarm boxes and the fire fighting equipment. There are 12 alarm boxes in the building located as follows:

- Inside front entrance door
- Beside fire exit doors end of main hall
- Beside rear exit door to car park
- Beside exit door in downstairs storage room (next to single toilet)
- In kitchen, right hand side of rear exit door
- Top of stairs outside kitchen
- In chair store
- On stage at top of stairs
- Top and bottom of stairs off stage

There are 4 large fire extinguishers located as follows:

- Main lobby
- Stage
- Rear door (exit to car park)
- Cloakroom/Meter Room

### **Do not use these water extinguishers on electrical equipment**

In the kitchen there is a small Powder fire extinguisher and a fire blanket.

In the event of a fire use the alarm box nearest you to set off the alarm, leave the building at the nearest fire exit close the doors and dial 999 for the fire Service. Fire assembly point is at the entrance to the car park at the rear of the building.

### Health and Safety including Fire Safety file

You must make yourself and all responsible adults in your group are **aware of the contents of this file** which is situated in the wall cupboard next to the back door of the kitchen

### First Aid

A box for First Aid is located in kitchen cupboard clearly marked. Any accident how ever small must be recorded in the book provided (kept with the First Aid Kit) and reported to the booking Secretary.

### Lighting, Heating and Appliances

The hire fees are inclusive of main lighting and background heating. Appliances and additional heating are payable through coin meters.

To use additional heating use the switch at the side of each radiator, the light will go on providing there is money in the meter.

## Use of Projector and PA system

Instructions on the use of the projector and an HDMI lead on located in the kitchen cupboard for the main hall and in a kitchen drawer in the committee room.

If you require the PA system, please ask the booking secretary for the padlock code. (The PA system will use the coin metered electricity, mentioned above [Black Box]).

## Use of Dishwasher and Glasswasher

Instructions on the use of the dishwasher and glass washer are located in the kitchen cupboard and on the Village Hall website. These are commercial washers and are different to domestic washers. They have a much shorter cycle but retain the hot water for multiple cycles. They do not empty the water at the end of the day. They need a user initiated action for this.

If you require the washers, please ask the booking secretary for details. Failure to empty the washers at the end of your session will lead to a loss of some of your deposit.

## Waste

To comply with recycling guidance of December 2019 in this area, please make sure you dispose of your waste in the correct bins as follows:

<b>GREEN BIN</b> Garden Rubbish only	<b>BLACK BIN</b> Non-recyclable Waste
<b>BLACK BOX</b> Plastic bottles, pots, tubs, trays Food & drink cans, biscuit tins, tin & metal lids, empty aerosols	<b>GREEN BOX</b> Thick cardboard, thin card, egg boxes Cereal boxes. Bottles and jars – all colours
<b>BLUE BAG</b> White paper, newspaper & magazines, directories & catalogues, junk mail & shredded paper, white window envelopes	<b>FOOD WASTE CADDY</b> All cooked and uncooked food
